Congratulations and welcome as you prepare for the baptism of your child. We look forward to the baptism of your child here at St. Ann's Church. It is a privilege for us to assist you in making the baptismal day one filled with meaning, prayerfulness and happiness. May God, the source of everything, fill your heart with every blessing.

## **Preparation for Baptism:**

## **Two Essential Steps:**

**Step 1**. Meet with priest, fill out the Baptism Intake Form and submit a copy of the Birth Certificate of the baby.

**Step 2.** Attend Pre-Baptismal instruction (documented).

- 1. Please bring required documents, if applicable as follows:
  - a. Copy of Birth Certificate
  - b. Letter of permission from your parish, if you are not a parishioner at St. Ann's
  - c. Sponsor Certificate for godparents, when necessary
- 2. Select a godparent; at least one Catholic godparent is necessary.
  - a. A godparent is a Catholic who is in good standing with the Church, practices the faith and has been baptized and confirmed. If married, he/she should be married in the Church.
  - b. A person from another faith/religion <u>may not</u> serve as a godparent. However, when there are two godparents (one of them a Catholic), a person from another Christian faith may serve as a Christian-Witness to the baptism.

- 3. Please attend Pre-Baptismal instruction which is held every first Sunday at 1:30 pm in the Church. (Step 2.)
- 4. For your convenience, an envelope for your Baptism donation is provided.
- 5. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated as follows:
  - a. Sundays at 1:30pm, except the first Sunday of the month.
  - b. No baptisms are scheduled on certain Holy Days.
- 6. Each year we celebrate a Mass of Thanksgiving for the newly baptized children and their families. This takes place in the Spring and the date is published in the parish bulletin.
- 7. We also celebrate a Mass for Pre-School age children and their families. This takes place in the Fall and the date is published in the bulletin.
